Background Education:

- BA or equivalent in Arts/Culture or Business/Management
- Proficiency in English

Fees:

Fees are dependent on the type of degree/diploma students will take:

- National Master degrees: The national practice of the host university is applied;
- Double Master degrees: The fee is a combination of the two national practices;
- Joint European Academic diploma: There is an International EMACIM fee (from 1500 € to 2400 €) to be confirmed by the EMACIM Board.
